

 - A. Moderately wooded gleciated peaks with elevations up to 8,000 feet. Sage covered alluvium-filled valleys at lower elevations.
 - B. Predominate formation of the area is the Medison limestone (Miss.) which overlies argillites and quartaites of questionable age, all have been folded and faulted. Tertiary volcanics overlie the above units in the lower valleys to the south.
 - C. Carnotite is the only uranium mineral noted and occurs as sparse powdery costings on joint and fracture surfaces of the argillite. A controlling structure has not been determined.
