The properties lie at the margin of a porphyritic quartz monzonite stock and are mostly in quartzites of the Prichard formation. Mineralization occurs in veins and as replacement deposits in the quartzites. The minerals are pyrrhotite, arsenopyrite, galena, sphalerite and minor amounts of bismuth, chalcopyrite and quartz.
