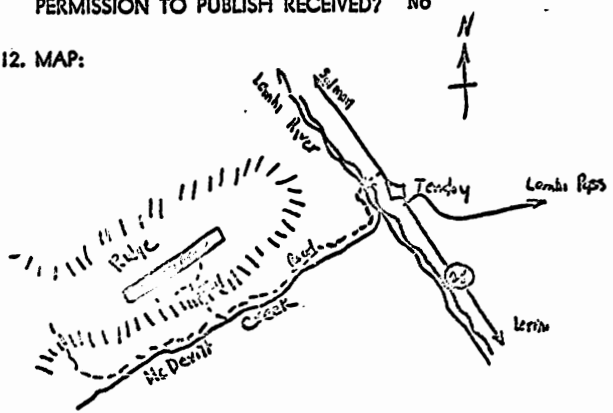
- A. Elev. 6000 ft. on minor ridge; open grassy steep hillside.
