- 2. DIRECTIONS TO PROPERTY: Drive up Squaw Creek to end of road. Continue on foot up Squaw Creek, somewhat less than a mile. Turn west up tributary about 1/2 mile. Deposits are on slope N. of this tributary.
- 3. OWNER OR LESSOR: Buck Westfall, Elmer Hagel, and Lee Ashe.
ADDRESS: North Fork, Idaho.

7. RADIOACTIVE DEPOSIT: TYPE AND AGE: Monazite-bearing carbonate layers and lenses, age unknown.

WALL ROCKS: Metamorphic rocks, chiefly hornblende gneiss and schist, and dark mica schist, which occur in a pendant of at least 20-square-miles area in Idaho batholith.

ORE MINERALS, PRIMARY: Monazite, rutile(?), probable allanite, possibly thorite(?); other unidentified

ORE MINERALS, SECONDARY: dark metallic to submetallic minerals, possibly ilmenite and Nb mineral.

CARBONATE MINERALS: Carbonate, actinolite, epidote, biotite or phlogopite, chlorite, magnetite, hematite; fluorite(?), sphene.

GENEALOGICAL RELATIONSHIP: Some hand specimens are more than 50 percent monazite.

ATTITUDE: N. 60° W. strike; 45-60° S. dip.

LENGTH (STRIKE OR OTHER): Several hundred feet.

SHAPE: Several concordant tabular layers and lenses

THICKNESS: About 10 ft in a 10-ft zone (No. 4 claim). (No. 4 claim).


